## Leadership Gifts

### **A Trusted Philanthropic Partner**

In 2008, the Massachusetts Lions Eye Research Fund delivered two major gifts in support of the Joslin's Beetham Eye Institute (BEI). These gifts are the latest in the Massachusetts Lions Eye Research Fund's longstanding philanthropic support of Joslin, which over the years has totaled more than \$5 million. The second gift of \$150,000 was the prestigious Lions' Presidential Grant, which was used to acquire a Spectral-Domain Optical Coherence Tomography instrument. This support is recognized by a permanently affixed plaque on the instrument identifying Massachusetts Lions Eye Research Fund and Lions International. CEO Ranch Kimball thanked them for their ongoing support at their annual meeting at the Joslin in February 2009.

### **Record-Setting Private Grant**

In 2008, the Joslin received a record-setting private grant from the Eli Lilly and Company Foundation. With a commitment of \$3 million over three years, the grant will allow Joslin researchers to explore the underlying causes of obesity and insulin resistance—two leading risk factors for diabetes and heart disease. Investigators involved with the project include Drs. C. Ronald Kahn (Principal Investigator), Mary-Elizabeth Patti, Aaron Cypess, Yu-Hua Tseng, Gerald Kolodny and Steven Shoelson. The multidimensional approach includes scientists from several Joslin research sections who will examine the origins of obesity and insulin resistance at the cellular level, including the role inflammation plays in these conditions, the influences of intrauterine and early nutrition, and new ways to image fat mass and function.

### **Going to Bat for the Kids**

Boston Red Sox first baseman—and member of the 2007 World Series Champion team—Kevin Youkilis has selected Joslin Pediatric Health Services as one of the beneficiaries of his Foundation, Kevin Youkilis Hits for Kids. Thanks to a generous donation of \$50,000 from Hits for Kids, a Joslin-authored guide for parents of children newly diagnosed with diabetes will be published in 2009.

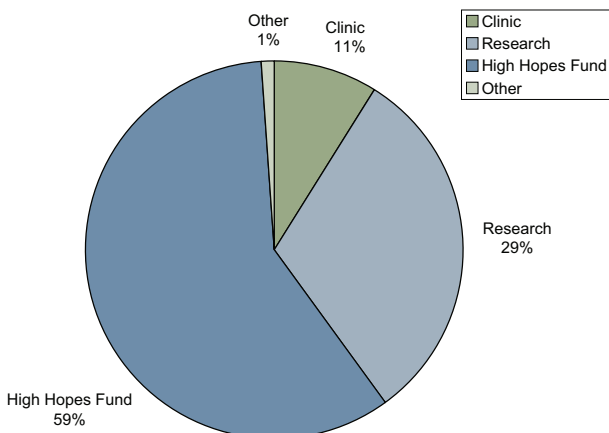

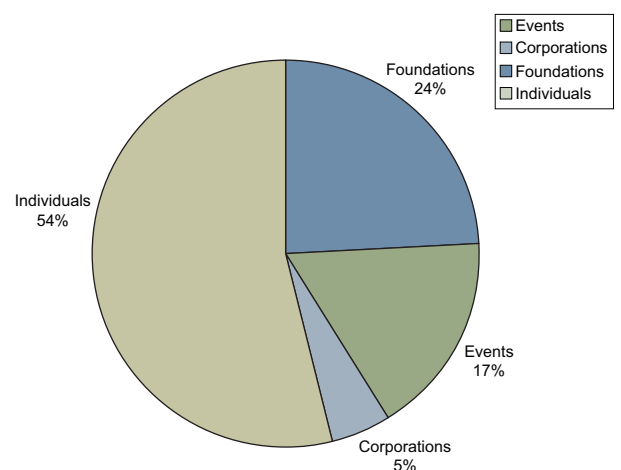
